

ESSER III (Draft)

Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

Section 2001(i) of the ARP Act requires an LEA that receives ARP ESSER funds to develop and make publicly available on the LEA's website, within 30 days after receiving its allocation, a plan for the safe return to in person instruction and continuity of services. Prior to making the plan publicly available, the LEA must seek public comment on the plan and take such comments into consideration when developing the plan. The LEA must also create an ESSER use of Funds Plan within 90 days of receiving their ESSER Funds. This plan should also be made publicly available on the LEA's website and submitted to ISBE.

*July 20, 2021 there will be a public board meeting with time devoted for public input on ESSER III funds and a return to full in-person learning.

*The district had several public board meetings with members of the community during the 2020-2021 school year. The district did reopen last March 2020 to in-person learning.

*The district is still waiting on final guidance from IDPH/ISBE/Will County Health department on what the rules will be for COVID safety protocols. The district plans to be full in-person learning for the 2021-2022 school year.

Staffing: \$150,000 (2022 & 2023)

Technology: \$150,000 (2022 & 2023)

Summer School: \$120,000 (2022, 2023 & 2024)

Learning Loss Staffing SW: \$90,000 (2022 & 2023)

After School Tutoring JH: \$40,000 (2022 & 2023)

Learning Loss Supplemental Learning Materials: \$200,000

Total: \$1.25 Million
